- 2. A well log or "as built" well plan indicating that each of our water sources is properly constructed.
- 3. Documentation indicating no submersible pumps are present at this water system or that our submersible pumps do not contain non-food grade oil or a PCB filled capacitor.
- 4. If any SOC samples have been taken, all results were "no detect".
