I got info back from the Forest Service. It appears that this area is just into what FS considers to be the North Zone. For that zone the recommended mx is:

Annual Ryegrass 13%
 Slender Wheatgrass 25%
 Prairie Junegrass 2%
 Western Wheatgrass 30%
 Canada Wildrye 30%

I see no issues with this mix so to keep things simple it is what I would recommend. Sorry this took so long. Let me know if you have any questions. Thanks
