This is my letter of intent to intervene

To whom it may concern:

I'm a historian in The Black Hills of South Dakota. I am vice president of The Society of The Black Hills Pioneers, and vice president of Lawrence County Historical Society, and at present time acting president. I am at this time and have been for several years deeply involved with cemeteries in the state, starting with 15 years of research on Saint Ambrose Cemetery in Deadwood, and culminating with my research on the cemetery board led by Vernon Davis. The rewards program for turning in vandals has been quit successful. I have recently written, and received a grant to launch a program from Lawrence County to take of all cemeteries, and graves in the county, and to educate individuals, and groups in the proper care of stones and monuments. I have in my possession a history of Wharfs' violations updated in 2008. I do not have a more recent account at this time, but reading these gives me a good reason to be concerned. Thus is my involvement in the preservation of Terry Cemetery, and my concern about the mining around it.

My concern now is the impact of the proposed mining at the Terry Peek area. I am concerned as to the impact of blasting and truck traffic in the vicinity of Terry Cemetery. In addition to that I would like to be assured that reclamation will include the back filling or shoring if you will of the area immediately around Terry Cemetery, legal description 4N, R2E, section 1 Mineral survey 989, Terry Cemetery.
