NOTICE OF BIOSOLIDS MANAGEMENT
APPLICATION AND RECOMMENDATION

The South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) has received an application for the issuance of a Biosolids Management permit from the following applicant:

The renewal of the Biosolids Management permit will allow the facility to land apply treated biosolids produced at the city of Aberdeen's wastewater treatment facility at appropriate agronomic rates.

Tentative determinations regarding the limits for land application, monitoring requirements, management practices and other conditions have been made by DENR. The Biosolids Management permit specifies the quality of biosolids that can be land applied and still protect public health, surface and ground waters of the state. The proposed Biosolids Management permit and supporting document are available from DENR at the address listed below.

In accordance with the Administrative Rules of South Dakota, Chapter 74:50:02, any person desiring to comment on the Department's recommendation for the conditional issuance of this permit must submit written comments to the below address within the specified thirty (30) day comment period. Comments may be directed to the following address: South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Services, Surface Water Quality Program, Joe Foss Building, 523 East Capitol, Pierre, SD 57501-3181. Any person desiring a public hearing must file a petition which complies with the ARSD 74:50:02. If no objections are received within the specified 30-day period, the Secretary will issue final determinations within sixty days of the date of this notice.
