

# NetDMR



## What is NetDMR?

NetDMR is a Web-based tool that allows discharge permittees to electronically sign and submit their discharge monitoring reports (DMRs). NetDMR is designed to reduce the burden on permittees, the state, and EPA. By using NetDMR, we can improve data quality; provide a cost savings; and better use limited resources to meet environmental goals. NetDMR allows permittees to complete a DMR that is specific to their permit limits and outfalls.

## How do I sign up for NetDMR Reporting?

South Dakota's NetDMR program is now available! We have completed our initial testing of NetDMR with a limited number of permittees. We are now ready to offer electronic reporting to other facilities required to submit DMRs.

SDDENR and EPA are offering training to begin using NetDMR. The training is a two part online training. During the training, you will be able to try out the system. You will learn to directly enter DMRs as well as import previously submitted DMRs from the system. Once you have completed the training and submitted a signed Subscriber Agreement to SDDENR, you will be approved to go "live" in time for your future DMR submittals!

### Notes:

1. Training is two 1½-hour sessions with additional time allotted for questions and answers if needed.

Training will be offered by EPA via Webinar (live, online training) on September 13 and 15, 2011, for selected facilities.

**WHO:** The person that will be signing the DMRs (the permit signatory or an authorized signatory), along with any other people that may be using NetDMR.

**WHEN:** September 13 and 15 from 12:00 pm—1:30 pm (Central Time).

**WHERE:** From your computer! The webinar is free and available over the internet.

## How Do I Register?

1. You must register by sending an email that includes your name, facility name, state, email address, and phone number for each attendee to [netdmr@epa.gov](mailto:netdmr@epa.gov).
2. After you register, you will receive an email from EPA with the website link and login information. You must also dial in on your telephone to hear live audio. Dial in information will be included in the email.
