

# NetDMR



## South Dakota's NetDMR program is now available!

We are offering electronic reporting to all facilities that are required to submit Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs).

## What is NetDMR?

NetDMR is a Web-based tool that allows discharge permittees to complete, sign, and submit their discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) electronically. NetDMR was developed to reduce the burden on permittees, the state, and EPA. By using NetDMR, we can improve data quality; provide a cost savings; and better use limited resources to meet environmental goals. NetDMR allows permittees to complete a DMR that is specific to their permit limits and outfalls.

Facilities that submit DMRs as required by a surface water discharge permit and want to use NetDMR, must take one of the NetDMR trainings prior to using NetDMR.

There are two types of NetDMR training courses currently available: local training and an online Webinar. Both trainings will show you how the NetDMR system works. You will learn how to create your account, submit the required subscriber agreement, and how to enter and submit DMRs.
