SUBJECT: Battle Creek Shutoff Order for Junior Priority Date Water Rights

Shutoff Order for Water Right Nos. ***

The flow in Battle Creek is below 1.5 cubic feet per second (cfs) at the USGS gaging station below Hermosa, SD. Therefore, to protect domestic use, the department is issuing shutoff orders to Battle Creek water rights. Effective immediately, diversions of water from Battle Creek will not be allowed until further notice.

Flow in Battle Creek has declined to the point where domestic use of water, which includes livestock watering from the river, has become a concern. This order will be rescinded as soon as conditions improve.

If conditions do not improve, this order will remain in effect until **December 31, 2013**.

I am asking for your cooperation in complying with this shutoff order. The ongoing drought is creating hardship for all the water right holders along the creek.
