We have just a couple comments on the October 7, 2008 supplemental information for Powertech's scenic and unique application that was given to us at the October 8 meeting in Edgemont.

1. In item 5, Powertech refers to a Table 1 by TE Myrick et al, but I did not see a Table 1 included in the supplemental information.
2. Stan Michals of Game, Fish, and Parks told me he did not receive the October 7, 2008 supplemental information in the scenic and unique package from Powertech that was Fed-Exed to him on October 6, 2008. Powertech will need to submit proof that each review agency was sent the October 7, 2008 supplemental information plus the above mentioned table. We would prefer that Powertech send the information to the agencies by certified mail/ return receipt requested to show that the agencies received the October 7 supplemental information. The Fed-Ex receipts in the October 3 supplement show that the packages were mailed, but do not prove that the agencies received the packages. Powertech will need to submit the return receipts to our office.

Also, the October 3 and October 7 supplemental information will need to be filed with the Custer and Fall River County Register of Deeds offices. Proof of filing of both supplements will need to be submitted to our office.

We will begin preparing the newspaper Notice of Intent to Operate that Powertech will need to publish in the Rapid City Journal. The notice will be forwarded to Powertech after we receive the information requested in this email. The public will then have 60 days after the publication date to submit petitions to nominate the area to the preliminary list.

We also noticed on the application form that was submitted with the October 3 information that there is a problem with the notary block. The block indicates that the application was notarized in South Dakota, but the notary is from Colorado. We are not sure whether the application was notarized in South Dakota or Colorado. The application form submitted with the August 21, 2008 submittal was correctly notarized. To make things easy, and if it is OK with Powertech, we will use the August 21 application form instead of the October 3 application form for the file.
