Response from Eric Holm, DENR:

Here is the letter. A copy was emailed to Frank Lichnovski, Richard Blubaugh, and Mark Hollenbeck, but not to you. I apologize for the oversight.

I have a couple other questions on the maps. First, on the soils map for the Dewey area, there is not a key for the soils types shown on the map. The soil types cannot be found on the key submitted with the maps.

The other question involves the Water Well maps. Some of the numbers and types shown on the map do not correspond with those shown on the table. Here is a summary of the discrepancies:

ID	Map Type	Table Type
3	dam	mine
5	dam	water well
14	abandoned well	spring
15	abandoned well	dam
17	water well	dam
31	mine	dam
41	abandoned well	water well
50	not on map (two #5's on map)	dam
636	abandoned well	water well
638	abandoned well	water well
652	abandoned well	water well

Also, a building that is shown in section 30; T6S-R1E on the map is shown in section 32 in the table.
