This letter confirms that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (SD DENR) have been developing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the two agencies regarding the procedures for reviewing financial assurance documents for the Powertech (USA) Inc., Dewey-Burdock uranium, in situ recovery facility in Fall River and Custer counties, South Dakota. This MOU was initiated as a result of a request by SD DENR for the NRC to hold the surety bond for the land application areas, which the SD DENR permits through an approved ground water discharge plan.
