Dear Ms. Rushin:

This is in regard to South Dakota's American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) infrastructure investments through the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF), the Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund (DWSRF), and Section 604(b) Water Quality Management Planning (§604(b)) programs.

Under ARRA, all funds appropriated to the CWSRF, DWSRF, and §604(b) programs must be under contract or construction and have assistance agreements in place by February 17, 2010, or be subject to reallocation. To implement the reallocation process, EPA requires that each State, by no later than March 1, 2010, certify in writing that projects funded under its CWSRF, DWSRF, and §604(b) ARRA grants have met the February 17, 2010 deadline.

I hereby certify that the CWSRF, DWSRF, and §604(b) ARRA projects, ARRA amounts obligated, dates of assistance agreements, amount of ARRA funds under signed contracts by February 17, 2010, and set-asides amounts taken, as shown in the attached tables, are true. I further certify that South Dakota fully met the ARRA deadline requirement of February 17, 2010, and that South Dakota has no CWSRF, DWSRF, or §604(b) ARRA funds subject to reallocation.
