SUBJECT: Preparation of Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision

The Water Management Board directed Thomas Brady, counsel for Croell Redi Mix, to prepare proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Final Decision in the matter of the approval of Water Permit Application No. 2745-2, Croell Redi Mix.

The Board will consider adoption of Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision at 11:30 AM, on Thursday, October 13, 2016, in the Floyd Matthew Training Center, Joe Foss Building, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre SD. The agenda time is an estimate and may be delayed due to prior issues on the agenda. Notice will be provided if there is a change in the hearing date or time.

The Board requested that the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision be mailed to each Board member and parties of record by September 22, 2016. Written objections or comments in support of the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision, or alternative Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision are to be mailed to each Board member, the Board attorney (mailing list enclosed), Water Rights Program counsel and other parties of record by September 30, 2016. Board counsel requests that the draft findings or alternative findings be provided in a WORD format file via email to [matthew.naasz@state.sd.us](mailto:matthew.naasz@state.sd.us).

At the Board's discretion, oral arguments in opposition or support of the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision, or alternative Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Decision may be made on October 13, 2016. The evidentiary hearing was completed July 7, 2016. No additional testimony will be received on October 13, 2016.
