

Notice of Meeting of the South Dakota Underground Pipeline Task Force

Notice is hereby given that the South Dakota Underground Pipeline Task Force will meet on Thursday August 14, 2008 at 10:00 A.M. CDT in Pierre, South Dakota. The meeting will be held in the Joe Foss Building at 523 E. Capitol Avenue in Pierre, South Dakota. South Dakota Codified Law Chapter 34A-18-10, establishes the South Dakota Underground Pipeline Task Force. The Task Force is made up of seven members appointed by the Governor who are to be knowledgeable of existing federal statutes and regulations and state statutes and rules which govern underground pipeline facilities for the transmission and distribution of water, natural gas, crude oil, ethanol, and refined petroleum products. The Task Force has two objectives. 1) Review the status of existing and proposed pipelines in South Dakota and 2) assess the adequacy of state laws and regulations relating to pipelines in South Dakota. The Task Force is to report its findings to the Governor no later than December 1, 2008.
