- 3. A copy of instruments of consultation from all surface landowners, if different than the owner of the minerals pursuant to SDCL 45-6B-12 and 13.



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PERMIT AMENDMENT APPLICATION

SMALL SCALE MINE PERMIT 479

7 May 2014

No road will be constructed for the express purpose of accessing the active mining areas. The trail mentioned in your letter of 26 March 2014 (i.e. road installed last year), was a preexisting trail. Some landscaping was conducted to fill an excavation by a previous miner. All disturbed areas have been contoured to grade and fully reclaimed and seeded. A silt fence has been placed between the trail and Rapid Creek to contain any erosion. Any further seeding will be applied as needed. Please include a 200 ton estimate for overburden removal, which was not addressed in the Amendment Application.

ARSD 74:29:03:03 (3 and 5):

Site Plan (Exhibit D) has been modified to indicate that containment berms will be "sediment and erosion controls as necessary".

ARSD 74:29:03:03 (6):

I have posted a \$2500.00 reclamation bond for a small scale mining permit.

There are no changes to the reclamation plan previously provided for Mine Permit No. 479

The timetable will not be impacted by this amendment.

Baseline data and maps have been submitted in Mine Permit No. 479.

ARSD 74:29:03:07:

There are no changes to the original reclamation plan for Mine Permit No. 479.

I will wait to send the application to the review agencies until your agency has determined the information requested is complete.


A copy will be submitted to the Pennington County Register of Deeds as well. The proof of submission letter will be forwarded to your agency.
