This is a request to have the following lands designated and named as the Fiddle Creek Field:

Section 24, Township 9 South, Range 1 East, All
Section 19, Township 9 South, Range 2 East, NW ¼, W ½ of the NE ¼
Fall River County, South Dakota (see map)

The minerals are owned 100% in the USA. The discovery well is the 3-24 Fiddle Federal, producing from the 1st and 2nd Leo sands.

I request spacing of one well per 40 acre spacing unit with all wells to be located not less than 800 feet from the nearest well completed in or drilling to the pool and not closer than 200 feet from the boundary of a spacing unit for the pool, for topographical reasons.

The stratigraphic interval to be spaced is the first, second, third, and fourth Leo intervals.
