**Gov. Noem Announces \$898,000 for Hudson Wastewater System  
Improvements**

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$898,000 Clean Waste State Revolving Fund loan for the City of Hudson to make wastewater system improvements.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Terms are 2.125 percent for 30 years.

“I am pleased to announce that the City of Hudson will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “The funding will help the city meet its wastewater treatment system needs and protect the environment.”

The project includes two phases. Phase one includes land acquisition and replacement of the existing wastewater lift station, installation of a generator, installation of approximately 2,800 feet of new force main, replacement of the control structure between the treatment lagoons, and a sludge survey.

The loan will cover the estimated cost of the project.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water and nonpoint source projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
