**Gov. Noem Announces \$2.7 Million for North Sioux City Water System
Improvements**

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$2,700,000 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan for North Sioux City to make drinking water system improvements.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 2.125 percent for 30 years.

“I am pleased to announce that North Sioux City will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “This funding will help the city complete needed upgrades to its water system to better serve its customers.”

The project includes construction of an additional elevated storage tank to provide additional storage capacity for the city. In addition, up to 1,000 feet of pipeline will be installed to connect the new water tower into the existing distribution system. The proposed location for the new water tower is along Waters Road between Military Road and Rickenbacker Road.

The loan will cover the total cost of the project.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for public drinking water system projects.
