Gov. Noem Announces \$150,000 for Huron Recycling Project

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$150,000 grant from the Solid Waste Management Program to help the City of Huron purchase a new recycle collection truck.

The grant will be administered by the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

“I am pleased to announce that Huron will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “The grant will help the city purchase a new recycle collection truck to better serve its customers.”

The city currently collects recycling products with a seven-year-old comingled recycle collection truck that no longer meets the city’s needs. The new collection truck will have a compactor body and an automated collection arm.

The grant, combined with local funds, will cover the \$300,000 cost of the collection truck.

The Solid Waste Management Program provides grants and loans for solid waste disposal, recycling and waste tire projects. The Legislature annually appropriates dedicated water and waste funding for the Consolidated and Solid Waste programs through the Governor’s Omnibus Water Funding Bill.

The board met today via remote video connection.
