Gov. Noem Announces \$1.21 Million for Delmont Wastewater System Improvements

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$1,210,000 loan for the City of Delmont to make wastewater system improvements.

The \$1,210,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan includes 100 percent principal forgiveness.

“I am pleased to announce that the City of Delmont will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “The funding will help the city make needed upgrades to its wastewater treatment and collection system to better serve its customers and protect the environment.”

Wastewater system improvements include replacement or relining of sewer mainlines throughout the community, upgrades at the wastewater treatment facility, and rehabilitation of a lift station.

The total estimated project cost is \$3,631,845. The loan along with funding from USDA Rural Development will cover the estimated cost of the project.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water and nonpoint source projects. Principal forgiveness is a subsidy option that results in a reduced loan payment amount for the borrower.

The board met today via remote video connection.
