Gov. Noem Announces \$671,000 for Lake Norden Wastewater System Improvements

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$671,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan for the City of Lake Norden to make wastewater system improvements.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 2.125 percent for 30 years.

“I am pleased to announce that the City of Lake Norden will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “The funding will help the city make needed lift station upgrades allowing the city to better serve its customers and protect the environment.”

The existing main lift station is deteriorated and has outlived its useful life. Project improvements include removal of the existing lift station, construction of a new lift station, installation of gravity sewer lines to connect the new lift station to the existing collection system, installation new force main, and installation of a generator.

The loan will cover the estimated cost of the project.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water and nonpoint source projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
