## **Gov. Noem Announces \$2.174 Million for Deer Mountain Sanitary District to Make Water System Improvements**

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$2,174,000 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan for Deer Mountain Sanitary District to make improvements to its drinking water system.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 2.125 percent for 30 years.

“I am pleased to announce the Deer Mountain Sanitary District will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “The loan will allow the district to expand its water system and provide a safe and reliable water supply to its residents.”

The project includes upgrades to or construction of a treatment system, a 110,000-gallon reservoir, distribution system piping and water meters, and new additional booster station. The improvements will allow the district to provide service to approximately 125 customers.

The loan will cover the estimated project cost.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for public drinking water system projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
