Gov. Noem Announces \$540,000 for Burke to Make Water System Improvements

PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Kristi Noem says the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$540,000 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan for the City of Burke to make improvements to its drinking water system.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 1.625 percent for 30 years.

“I am pleased to announce Burke will receive this assistance,” said Gov. Noem. “The loan will allow the city to make needed upgrades to its water system and better serve its customers.”

The project includes replacement of the water distribution system near the Burke Regional Hospital under Eight Street and Jefferson Street and extension of the water main along Eighth Street from Jefferson Street to County Road 23. A total of 2,060 feet of 6-inch and 8-inch PVC pipe will be installed.

The loan along with local funds will cover the estimated project cost.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for public drinking water system projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
