DENR Announces \$1,539,000 Loan for City of Custer Wastewater System Improvements

PIERRE, S.D. – Today, the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) announced the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$1,539,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan for Custer to make wastewater system upgrades.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 2.125 percent for 30 years.

The loan will fund the first phase of a multiphase project. Phase 1 includes improvements to the wastewater treatment facility including rehabilitating four existing pond structures, valve replacement, and slip-lining of the existing force main location from the wastewater treatment facility to the chemical feed building. These improvements will ensure residents continue to receive reliable wastewater services. The loan will also provide funding for design of the two remaining phases.

The loan along with local funds will cover the estimated project cost.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water and nonpoint source projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
