## **DENR Announces \$2,487,000 Funding Package for Town of Saint Lawrence Wastewater System Improvements**

PIERRE, S.D. – Today, the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) announced the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$2,487,000 funding package for Saint Lawrence to make wastewater system improvements.

The funding package includes a \$396,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan, a \$102,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund Build America Bonds grant, and a \$1,989,000 Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program grant.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 2.125 percent for 30 years.

Saint Lawrence plans to replace approximately 13,175 feet of wastewater line and rehabilitate its lift station. This project will ensure Saint Lawrence can continue to provide reliable wastewater services to its residents.

The funding package will cover the estimated project cost.

The Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program, funded in part by revenues from the Petroleum Release Compensation Tank Inspection fee and the sale of lotto tickets, provides grants and loans for water, wastewater, and watershed projects.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for wastewater, storm water, water conservation, and nonpoint source projects.
