DENR Announces \$360,000 Loan for Kingbrook Rural Water System Drinking Water Improvements

PIERRE, S.D. – Today, the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) announced the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a \$360,000 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan for Kingbrook Rural Water System (RWS) to make drinking water system improvements.

The loan will be administered through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Loan terms are 1.625 percent for 30 years.

Kingbrook RWS plans to rehabilitate the Carthage water tower. A recent inspection found the interior and exterior of the water tower and its steel roof to be in poor condition. This loan ensures the water tower remains in service to supply Carthage residents clean and reliable drinking water.

The loan and local funds will cover the estimated project cost.

The State of South Dakota and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency fund the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program, which provides low-interest loans for public drinking water system projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
