DENR Announces \$247,450 in Grants for City of Miller Drinking Water and Wastewater Improvements

PIERRE, S.D. – Today, the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) announced the Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved \$247,450 in grants for the city of Miller to make drinking and wastewater improvements.

The grants include a \$134,750 Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program grant for wastewater improvements and a \$112,700 Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program grant for drinking water improvements.

These funds were previously awarded to Miller but were unable to be utilized due to construction delays stemming from the COVID-19 pandemic. These funds are for Phase II of Miller's drinking water and wastewater system upgrades.

The Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program, funded in part by revenues from the Petroleum Release Compensation Tank Inspection fee and the sale of lotto tickets, provides grants and loans for water, wastewater and watershed projects.

The board met today via remote video connection.
